AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution be forwarded to the following public officials: "MP Marc Serré, MPP John Vanthof Tamiskaming-Cochrane, Premier of Ontario The Honourable Doug Ford, Leader of the Official Opposition Andrea Horwath, Prime Minister of Canada The Honourable Justin Trudeau, and Leader of Official Opposition The Honourable Erin O'Toole."
