Attention Drivers!

With the arrival of September, all drivers must pay extra attention to the road. If you see the red flashing lights on a stationary school bus, you must come to a full stop to allow the bus to load or unload children from it safely. Only moving when the lights stop flashing.

Failing to do so will come with severe penalty of 6 demerit points, a minimum fine of \$490.00, dramatic increases to your insurance costs, and a 30 day suspension if you are a G1 or G2 license driver.

Please also be mindful of your speed in a school zone. The speed limit within a school zone is 30-40km/h.

Did you know?

The library is open on Saturdays starting on Saturday, September 9th. The library will be open in Markstay from 10:00am to 12:00pm, and Warren library will be open at 1:00pm to 4:00pm.

Community Article - September 2023

In time like these, we recognize that food insecurities have escalated to include families whose parents are gainfully employed but have difficulty meeting their needs with rising costs associated with home and family. It is important that people realize there is no shame in needing a hand up.

A small group of people has been working to bring a food bank location to the village of Warren to facilitate access for local residents. The municipal council is encouraging us in this endeavor. We are not in competition with the Food Bank in Markstay but wish to enhance access for residents closer to our location. **Households will need to decide** which one food bank they will register with.



The families will need to fill out a form to register so we can order enough for each one and also so we can co-ordinate

with other food banks in our area so none are left out. It should ease the need to travel longer distances to access assistance, if you are closer to one place than to another. We are a large geographical area and we want all to benefit. Perhaps there could (in future) be locations for food pick up between villages.

It is the hope of our committee that we will be up and running in September. We have been painting the rooms and trying to set up shelving. We are currently waiting to find out when Sudbury Food Bank will begin deliveries to this location. These deliveries are being made possible by the Manitoulin-Sudbury District Services Board, who also gave us a 'start up' gift. Helping Hands Missions has also offered to supply food.

We have purchased a refrigerator and freezer to accommodate food items requiring that type of storage. It would be wonderful if any local producers could offer occasional help, such as surplus produce in season, or eggs.

If there are people willing to volunteer on distribution days, we would welcome that.
