

Sports Culture and Recreation Programmer—Library

- Support summer reading and literacy activities through active and creative programming.
- Periodically assist patrons with the use of electronic devices, access to library resources, and collection maintenance.
- Assist with attendance tracking, setup, cleanup, and program organization.
- Promote library programs through displays, social media, and community outreach.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Students aged 15–30
- Registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year and intending to return to full-time studies in the next academic year.
- Current Police Record Check, including a Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to work at both the Markstay and Warren branch locations.
- The successful candidate will help create safe, engaging, and inclusive experiences that encourages physical activity, teamwork, and community participation.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, teamwork, and leadership skills.
- Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
- Experience leading, or an interest in leading, groups of children and youth.
- Bilingualism will be considered an asset.
